Talk about being well connected! The hottest Spring day for almost seventy years provided a perfect backdrop to the LSS pre-season Get-Together at Stand GC arranged by Keith (G), who obviously knows the right weather gurus. The 35 strong field found the course in excellent condition, irrespective of the prolonged Winter, with some impressive scores, as described below. Our opening 2018 season match against Formby Hall GC Captain's Team on 1st May sees LSS Match Captain, Andrew Walmsley, field a team from the four corners of Lancashire against the squad of host club Captain, Paul Conlon.

21st May takes us to Penwortham GC against SDGA Seniors, who are captained this year by SDGA's Vice Chairman, Allan Harrison of S&A GC. Manchester GC's Ken Stafford will be keen to repeat the 2017 result when LSS showed SDGA a clean pair of heels at his home club.

Two matches/events in June, three in July and four each in August and September, sees a busy Summer of seniors golf.
