PALATINE TROPHY: DAVYHULME PARK GC; 18th September 2018:

Albert Woodtli, one of the pioneering members of the Lancashire County Seniors team in the early 1980's and a member of Davyhulme Park GC, will be joining us for the day, together with the Captain of Davyhulme Park GC.

AND NOW FOR SOMETHING DIFFERENT: 'LEGENDS OF GOLF HISTORY TRAIL TOUR':

Southport's reputation as a world-class golfing location was brought vividly to life during the recent 'Legends of Golf History Trail Tour' at Royal Birkdale, S&A and Hesketh Golf Clubs. Prize winner and Formby Hall GC member, Dave Gant, together with three friends, Derek Johnstone, Alan Reeves and Alan Carter, were treated to a day with a difference by Hesketh GC Historian, Keith Hick. Keith, who devised the tour on behalf of the Lord Street, Southport, based Atkinson Arts & Culture Centre Development Trust, led the group through the unique history of golf throughout the Golf Coast during the day long tour. Royal Birkdale's Historian, John Rostron, hosted the opening part of the tour around the club's iconic Art Deco club house, explaining how the Open Championship, Ryder Cup and many other prestigious events, together with past members, Ronnie White and Frances 'Bunty' Smith, had put the club firmly on the map. Walker Cup player and Captain, Dr David Marsh, together with Paul Bagshaw and S&A GC Club Captain, Martin Bennett, then entertained the party to lunch at S&A before sharing anecdotes from the very pinnacle of the professional and amateur game, recalling how the 1933 and 1937 Ryder Cups hosted by S&A almost presaged the club becoming the permanent home of the Ryder Cup from 1941 onwards......

The golfing Doctor's first-hand account of his historic second shot to the famous 'Road hole' at St Andrews in 1971, to help GB&I win the Walker Cup, enthralled the party.

Then it was on to Hesketh for the afternoon where Club President, Derek Holden, described how Hesketh's Harry and Arnold Bentley swept all before them in the inter-war years, including Arnold, together with Bridlington/Ganton GC member, Tommy Thirsk, winning the 1936 Berlin Olympic Games exhibition golf tournament, 'Golf Pries de Nationen', with the tournament trophy being donated by Adolf Hitler. Keith wrapped up the day with his hour-long illustrated talk 'How Golf put Southport & the Golf Coast on the World Map'
