A distinct change of mood and a feeling of optimism. LANCASHIRE SUPER SENIORS 2 MORECAMBE GC SENIORS 10 12TH August:

Only a few weeks after the inaugural match against Isle of Man Seniors, LSS returned to Morecambe to face the might of 'Rory's Regulars', aka Morecambe GC Seniors. As ever, the welcome and hospitality Swamy Narayana's team received was warm, and so was the roasting metered out to his LSS squad. As a master match play protagonist, Rory has few peers and he had obviously inspired his team to scale the heights, leading off the charge with Chris Homer for a 2/1 win against Clitheroe's Swamy and Paul Kelly of Formby GC. Keith G and Jeff Clements of Stand GC had hopes of at least a half against Les Pritchard and Malcolm Partington, but the home pair also eased home on the 17th. With home club Match Captain, Peter Vovett-Hall and club Secretary, Alec Cooper, beating Stuart Bourn and Malcolm Evans, LSS had a hill to climb. Then Dave Hodge (Hesketh) and Ronnie Webster (Heysham) won on the last to give LSS a vestige of hope, only for the last two matches to go to the hosts.

Shot of the day belonged to Stuart Bourn who holed out for an eagle 2 on the 8th – well done Stuart! Post match 'craic' was excellent, as was the catering and the two Match Captains exchanged 'thank you's' after the evening meal, looking forward to the 2020 match.

LANCASHIRE SUPER SENIORS 8 CUMBRIA SENIORS 4: Heysham GC; 4th August:

The 2018 match at Grange-over-Sands had seen LSS prevail, so we knew Stephen Rooke's Cumbria team would be itching for the chance to gain revenge this year. With a venue in prime late summer condition, Heysham looked picture postcard perfect and with rain clearing just prior to the 'off', the waiting was soon over as LSS Match Captain, Keith G and Lindsey Groves (St Annes OL) got proceedings under way against Paul Flynn and Tom Hill. Reversing an early deficit, Keith and Lindsey walked off the 18th one up, soon to be followed by Hesketh's Keith H, partnered by Fairhaven's Clive Appleby, who just outlasted Peter Robinson and Geoff Bell with some dogged par golf to win on the 17th. Then along comes home club 'Maestro' Peter Hampsey, partnered by club colleague, Ronnie Webster, who also won 2/1 against

Playing his 'stinger' Rookie and Alan Calvert held off close pal Chris Rogers (Hesketh) and Royal Birkdale's Roger Cox to prove Cumbria had a sting in the tail.
