# LANCASHIRE SUPER SENIORS 5 FORMBY GC SENIORS 7; Formby GC; Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2021:

If ever there is a golfing Nirvana Formby would factor in highly. The vista welcoming everyone upon arrival at this majestic Lancashire links was well nigh perfect. Golf courses, (yes, there are Ladies' and Men's courses) stretching out framed by distant pine trees, whetted the golfing appetite. Formby Seniors Match Captain, LSS compatriate Mal Morton, welcomed everyone as we tucked into bacon baps overlooking the 18<sup>th</sup> green. Hosts to the Staysure Seniors' Open the previous week, Formby's greenstaff were ensuring the stimp meter readings were maintained, with the iron plying back and forth across the greens before play began.

Pual Jenkins and Steve Morgan accounted for Clive Wilson and Terry Pottage, rapidly followed by Dave Thirlwell and Nigel Tootill beating Chris Rogers and Alan Swift on the 17<sup>th</sup> to give Formby an unassailable lead.

Then came a battle royal with the two one handicappers and their partners in the last game. Huw Lewis-Jones and Shaun Thomas couldn't quite muster the firepower to match Allan Harrison and Andy Tiso for the visitors to win 2 up.

A splendidly convivial après golf evening meal was followed by Formby Captain, John Hussey, formally welcoming LSS, paying tribute to Mal Morton for arranging such an enjoyable match, adding how much Formby had enjoyed playing hosts on such a superb day for golf.

In response, LSS Match Captain Keith Hick thanked John for his warmth of welcome and hospitality, recalling how far LSS had come in such a short time and Formby as a happy hunting ground during his time as Hesketh's Scratch and Colts team captain.

The next stage of reopening from the latest covid lockdown coincided with the long awaited return fixture against Cumbria Seniors at Penrith on 16 August.

Whilst many of the golfers may initially have struggled to get used to the new found freedom of movement in the clubhouse, the Cumbrian players certainly wasted no time in asserting themselves on the golf course. Cumbria raced out into an early, and ultimately unassailable, lead by winning the first four matches but Lancashire Super Seniors rallied to win the final two matches to see Cumbria win 8-4.

The opening match saw team captains Dave Harrison and John Pinder partnered by Chris Rogers and Denis Wright respectively. Once John and Denis established an early lead, Dave and Chris struggled to make much of a dent even with successive birdies at the turn with the Cumbrian pairing winning 5&4. The same result occurred in the second match where Clive Appleby and Keith Hick found it difficult to handle some excellent golf from Martin Hodgson and Harry Horridge. In the third game, Even an eagle 2 from Keith failed to dent the home pair's resolve. Andy Tiso and Ian Bond took Duncan Miller and Peter Robinson down the 18th but Cumbria prevailed by the finest of margins.
